


Disaster Event – Far North Queensland Upper Level Trough, 21 – 23 May 2016



Event and Timing –

Between 21 and 23 May 2016, a complex upper-level trough over Far North Queensland generated heavy rainfall and associated flooding across several regions.

Assistance Activated –

The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services, activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).


NDRRA Relief Measures Activated –
