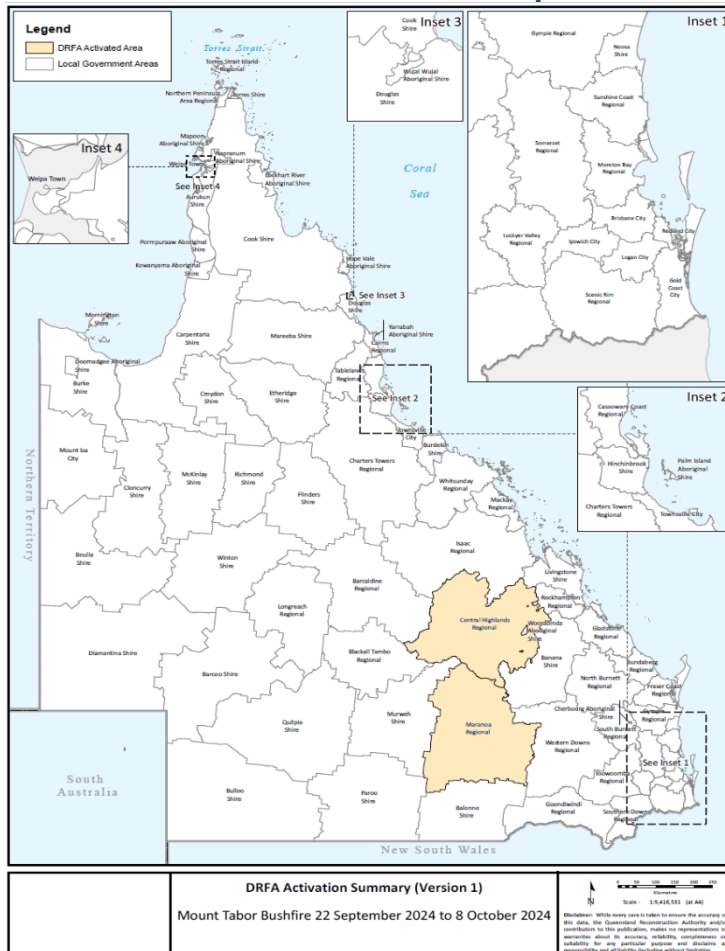


Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements event

Mount Tabor Bushfire 22 September 2024 to 8 October 2024 (V1)



The Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) is a jointly funded program between the Australian Government and state and territory (state) governments, through which the Australian Government provides financial assistance to support state governments with disaster recovery costs.

In response to the disaster, assistance has been activated for the area formally defined as: **“Communities within Central Highlands Regional Council and Maranoa Regional Council impacted by Mount Tabor Bushfire 22 September 2024 to 8 October 2024.”**
